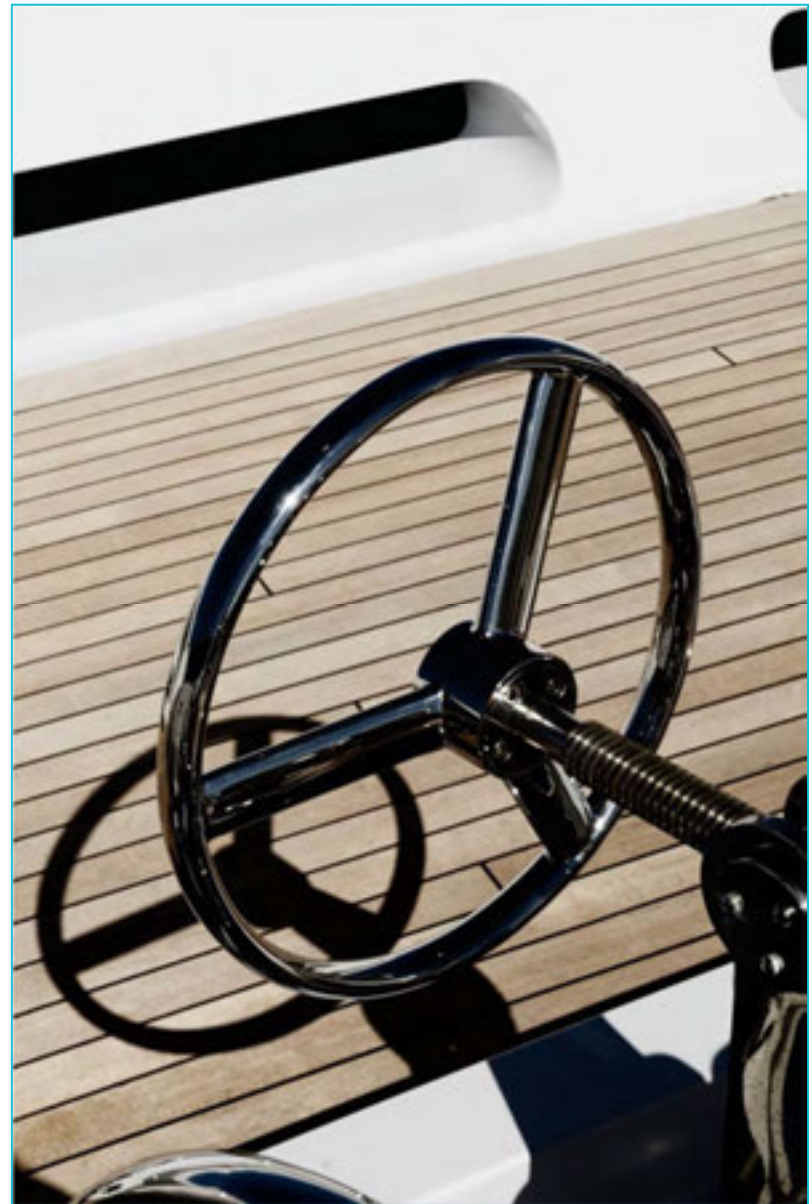

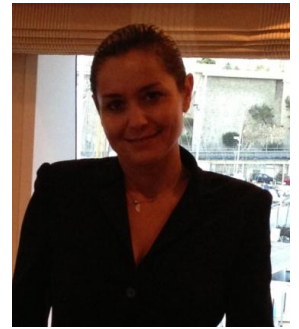


**CHIEF STEWARDESS – Alessandra Bellanova**

New Zealand

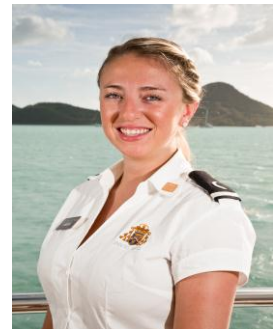

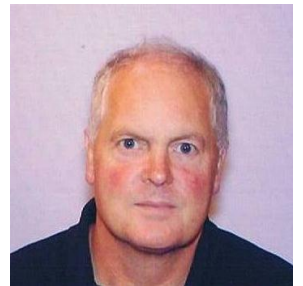


### **CHIEF ENGINEER – Villy Sorenson**

Languages: Danish, fluent English

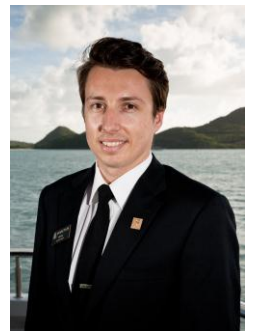

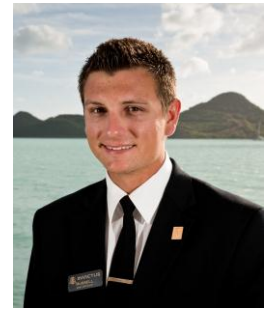

American

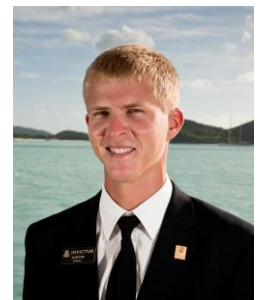

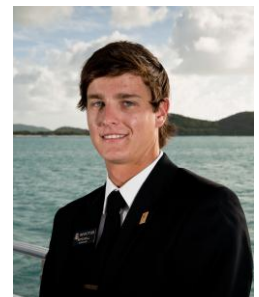


**DECKHAND – Mitchell Williams**
